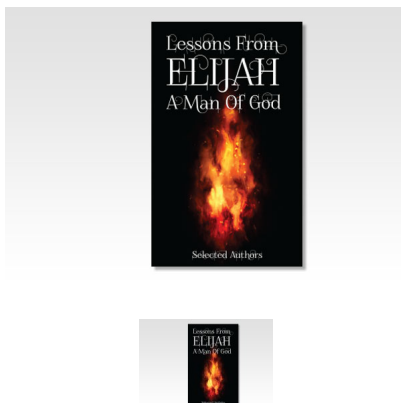




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Description

Elijah was one of the greatest Old Testament prophets, yet no Bible book bears his name, and his work was limited more or less to special occasions with long periods in between. But what a blessed man he was, being one of two Old Testament believers to have had the privilege of being "raptured" to heaven without dying! He also had the immense privilege of visiting with the Lord on the mount of Transfiguration about 900 years later. Some of us, too, will be raptured to glory, never having to physically die—the rest of us being raised from the grave to take our place in the rapture of all believers.
